Part 3: Still Standing

Sitrep

Date: June 25th 2012

There is war in Takistan. The International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) is on a security mission in Takistan. ISAF is a key component of the international community's engagement in Takistan, assisting the Takistan authorities in providing security and stability, in order to create the conditions for reconstruction and development.

As of late, a militia has grown. This militia do small attacks from time to time on ISAF troops and positions. A few towns in the north east region of Takistan is lacking water. The wells were destroyed during the last militia attack.

With the re-watering project up and running, and with the new control of the area, the situation has change. The north west airfield is now controlled by the ISAF. The oilfield is cleared and as the last pillars of smoke are fading, the Takistani Army show their power by mobilizing more troops from the south west.

Date: July 2nd 2012

During the last few days they have set up a stronghold in Feruz Abad. They are heavily armed with MBTs and APCs patrolling the nearby area. Takistani scouts have been reported throughout the area, all the way from Nagara to Feruz Abad. A local news station received photos from a young boy who was wandering in the area near the mine, north of Feryz Abad. The boy was walking his dog and sometimes visits the old mine. This time he saw several military men mounting something in the area. Three or four trucks which – at first – was identified as fuel trucks were driving in from the road towards the mine, with guard escort, according to the boy.

The trucks are the same trucks that a US recon group spotted further south a few days ago. These trucks are loaded with explosives in liquid form, and also a highly neurotoxic liquid. A possible reason for using this liquid could very well be the interest in working with biochemical warfare.

Mission plan

The trucks at the mine must be captured and controlled. At the same time we must suppress the Takistai Army by neutralizing the stronghold in Feruz Abad [*named Atlantis*]. When Atlantis is sunk we can more safely take control of the terrain around the mine and secure the trucks [*objective Poseidon*]. Victor Lima will have to do precision strafes with the A10 to take out any possible armour near the route towards Poseidon.

Keep in mind that there are civilians in the area. All attacks must be cleared via the TACP and Sierra Lima before you attack.

Quebec Lima will provide the convoy with close support. It is imperative that you protect the trucks on the way back to base.

Assets

The company will have access to several HMMWVs.

Victor Lima will have access to attack helicopters and an A10. Transports are also available.

Charlie Sierra will be at Sierra Lima's disposal.

Quebec Lima have Strykers and a Bradley at their disposal.

Intelligence report

We have reason to believe that the army have troops hidden around the area as a UAV spotted a M113 squad in the mountains south of Mulladost a day ago.

Stationary AA may also be near but none has been spotted.

Objectives

Alpha and Bravo squads

1. Move via convoy fast towards Bastam. Secure the area and move on to Falar and Feruz Abad.
2. Secure the trucks at *Poseidon*.

Charlie Sierra

1. Scout, provide support. Sierra Lima will give you details

Viktor Lima

1. Get the birds and the A10 flying. The TACP will stay in close contact as the convoy moves.

Quebec Lima

1. Support Alpha with Strykers or Bradley.
